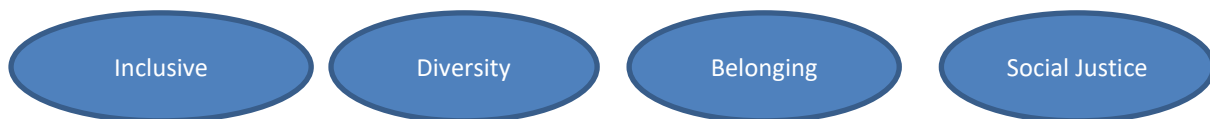
This workshop addresses how these forms of oppression manifest in both personal and professional contexts, and introduces pedagogical tactics to foster inclusive environments.
